Cardinals crush Redsidies in final game

The Ione Cardinals defeated the South Wasco County Redsidies 77-14 in their final football game of the season. The Cardinals scored early and often on their home field in the lopsided victory. Ione completely overwhelmed South Wasco, scoring 46 points in the first quarter.

Cord Flynn rushed for two touchdowns (TD) and returned an interception for another. Alessandro Panozzo also rushed for two TDs and caught a third. In addition, Panozzo scored point(s) after touchdowns (PAT) rushing, receiving and kicking, contributing 23 points for the Cardinals.

South Wasco quarterback Dawson Herlocker connected with end Brody Myers for a TD in the second quarter. Keith Kegal punched in the PAT for the Redsidies.

Ione freshman Aaron

Smythe sped 55 yards on his first carry for a touchdown to begin the second quarter. Smythe would add another TD in the quarter and finish the game with 88 yards rushing. The Cardinals would lead at half 58-8.

Nestor Ramirez, Jason Juarez and Donald McElligott each added rushing TDs in the second half. Jorge Aguilar plowed through the defense for a second half PAT. Hector Aguilar and Dan Doherty each caught passes from Jason Juarez for PATs.

“Our team was disappointed not to make the playoffs this season,” Coach Weiper said. “The team did, however, improve each week and played competitive football at the end of the season. It was good to play very well in the last game of the season,” he added.

Looking forward to next season, Weiper finished, “Many players contributed to the victory, and many will return next year.”

The Cardinals finish the season at 3-5 overall and 2-4 in the Big Sky Conference. The team persevered through a tough schedule and injuries to key players such as Henry Padberg and Jason Juarez. Look for the Cardinals to work hard in the off season, build their discipline and skills, and achieve great things in 2016.

The Redsidies, who were without their starting quarterback, would score in the fourth when Dawson Herlocker again found Brody Myers through the air for a touchdown.

Ione Coach Stan Weiper said the entire defense played well behind the solid efforts of defensive tackles Jorge Aguilar and Sergio Marin. Pablo Ramos halted a South Wasco drive in the second half with an interception. Donald McElligott would lead the team with 10 tackles.
