DA's Report

Morrow County District Attorney Justin Nelson has released the following report:
-Skyler Zackery Willia Clements, 20, was convicted of Harassment, a Class B Misdemeanor. Sentence of 90 days jail time was suspended and the defendant sentenced to 24 months bench probation, to include 40 hours of community service and no offensive physical contact with either of the victims. An additional charge of Assault IV was dismissed. Fines, fees and assessments totaled \$350.
-Melody Coake, 51, was convicted of Harassment, a Class B Misdemeanor. Sentence of 90 days jail time was suspended and the defendant sentenced to 24 months bench probation, to include a written apology to the victim and no offensive physical contact with the victim. Additional counts of Assault IV and Criminal mischief II were dismissed. Fines, fees and assessments totaled \$200.
-David Lynn Bailey, 52, was convicted of Theft I, a Class C Felony, and sentenced to 18 months prison time with credit for time served, with one year post-prison supervision. An additional count of Criminal Trespass II was dismissed. Fines, fees, assessments and restitution totaled \$1,700.
