## DA's Report

Morrow County District Attorney Justin Nelson has released the following report:

-Tareena Lee Healy, 46, was convicted of Contempt of Court. Of the sentence

of 90 days jail time, all 90 days were suspended and the defendant sentenced to 12 months bench probation with various conditions, including 30 days to request return of a black Ruger .22 pistol from the sheriff's office and compliance with any outstanding restraining orders. A second count of Contempt of Court was dismissed. Fines, fees and assessments totaled \$100.

-Dustin Dale Rodriguez, 25, was convicted of Possession of Methamphet-

amine, a Class C Felony. The defendant's driver's license was suspended for six months and the defendant sentenced to 18 months supervised probation subject to 90 sanction units with 30 jail units. Probation conditions included 80 hours of community service, and defendant will be allowed to apply for misdemeanor treatment upon successful completion of probation. Fines, fees and assessments totaled \$500.
