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Justice Court Report

Morrow County Justice of the Peace Ann Spicer has released the following Justice Court report:

-Thomas Wade Mathew, 22, of Heppner was found guilty of no ops and fined \$260.

-Giselle Moses, 41, of Heppner was found guilty of driving under influence of intoxicants (DUII) and was fined \$1,500. Of the

sentence of 180 days jail time, 175 days were suspended and the defendant sentenced to five days in jail. The defendant was also sentenced to two years bench probation, conditions to include 100 hours of community service, alcohol evaluation and treatment, and a letter of apology submitted through the district attorney's office.

DA's Report

Morrow County District Attorney Justin Nelson has released the following report:

-Amanda Suzanne Vaughan, 41, was convicted of Theft III, a Class C misdemeanor; execution of the sentence of 30 days jail time was suspended and

the defendant sentenced to 24 months bench probation. Probation conditions include 10 hours community service, as well as alcohol evaluation and any recommended treatment. Fines, fees and assessments totaled \$200.

Authorizes additional transfer to other funds of \$25,944 by the General Fund Weed Dept. in order to set up a reserve for future capital equipment purchases. In addition authorizes additional special payments by General Fund - Non Departmental of \$1,287,082 due to a change at the state level. Previously the OHA R-Base Addictions and Mental Health allotment funding was provided directly to the County's Menta Health Services provider, those funds are now required to pass through the County. This modification allows Morrow Co. to pass these funds through to the providing entity. The results of the above modifications are total Transfers to Other Funds are now a total of \$952,444, Special Payments a total of \$1,287,082 for a total increase in appropriations of \$1,313,026. Total requirements for the County General Fund are now \$14,068,246 of which \$1,563,792 is unappropriated ending fund balance.
