The Arlington Jackpot Rodeo kicks off its 69th year April 30 and May 1 at Arlington, OR. Events will begin Saturday, April 30, with the parade through downtown Arlington at 10 a.m. and the queen's luncheon immediately following the parade at the United Methodist Church hall, 150 Hemlock St.
Rodeo action begins at 12:30 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday. A cowboy breakfast will be served on Sunday at the Masonic Hall from 7-10 a.m.
Arena action will feature the traditional rodeo events, including bull riding and ranch bronc riding. There will be added money each day, except for specialty events. The specialty events will be mutton bustin', junior and pee-wee barrel racing, steer riding and a calf scramble. The 14th annual Kevin Johnson Memorial buckle will be awarded to the all-around cowboy or cowgirl. The cook shack will be serving food both days.
Ticket prices are \$6 for adults and \$4 for children

12 and under. A two-day pass is available for \$9 for adults and \$6 for children 12 and under.
