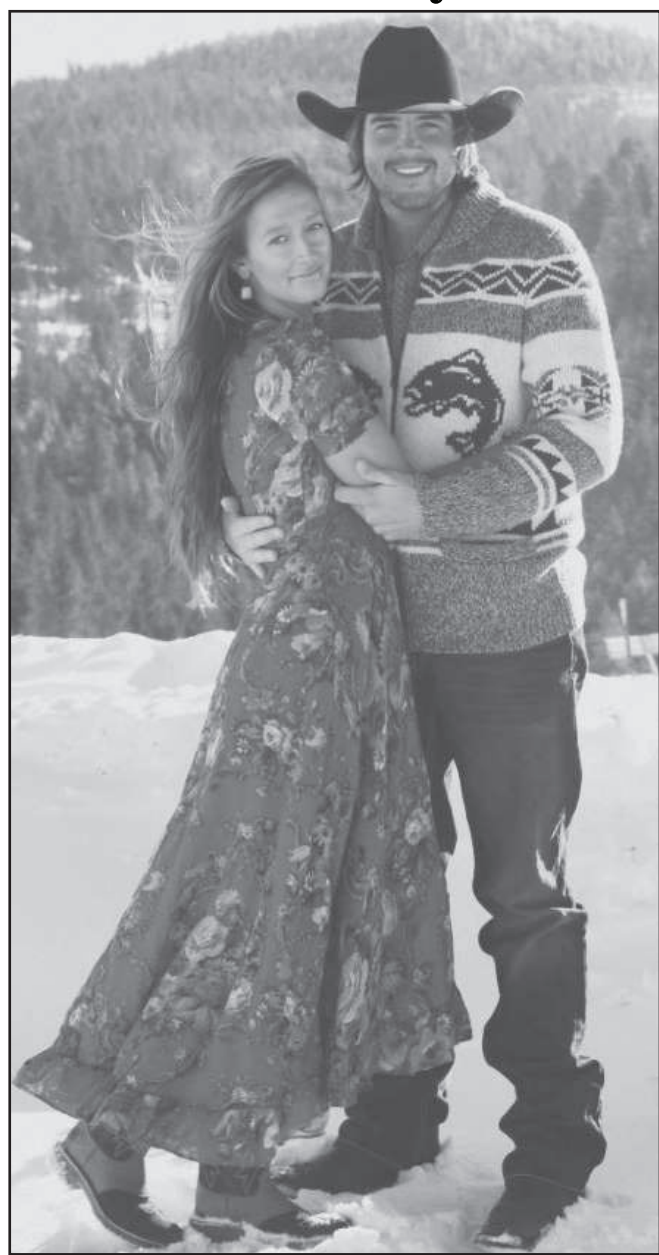

**Sheriff's Report**
