

## Sheriff's Report

**October 4:** Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report of criminal mischief at Heppner High School on NW Morgan St, Heppner.

-MCSO responded to a motor vehicle accident at Hwy 730, Boardman. Female over corrected and crossed the center line into the ditch.

The supplemental budget would authorize an increase in Victim Witness Total Revenue, Personnel and Materials and Services Expenditures with the increase in VOCA/CFA Non-Competitive Grant funds for 2017. The annual grant award is \$45,929 with a required match of \$11,482 in Personnel. The additional revenue increase includes a request from "Transfer from Other Funds" from General Fund for the match and to balance the Fund. There is also an increase in Beginning Fund Balance which includes unspent dollars from the "VOCA One Time Grant".
