

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

September 29: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on Kunze Ln, Boardman that their black lab is missing. Last seen yesterday afternoon. Advised dog is 14 years old, male, black lab cross that is deaf, weighs about 45-50 lbs, has speckles on half of its face. Blue collar, no tags, very friendly, name is Jack.
