

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

October 31 (cont.): Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a complaint on I 84 W, Boardman of a belly dump, dark in color with gravel, throwing rocks all over the place. Referred to another agency.

-MCSO received a report on SE Greenwood St, Irrigon of a Chihuahua running around on her property, runs at large all the time.

-MCSO received a call from a male subject asking to speak to someone regarding sex offender registration in Oregon. He is from Minnesota and knows the rules are different between states.
