

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

November 6: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report at Hwy 206 Condon/Redding Rd, Heppner that they found a black and white border collie. RP called back and picked up the dog to return to its rightful owner.

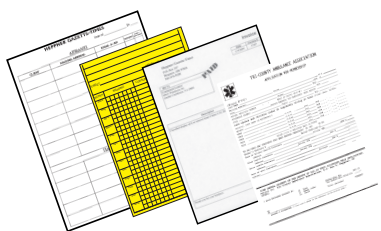

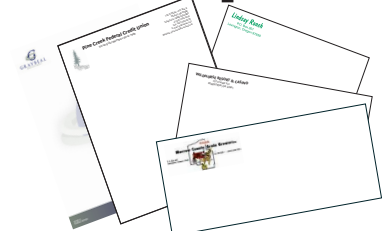
