

## Sheriff's Report

### The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

**November 20:** Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on SE Ninth St, Irrigon of motion in the garage.

-MCSO received a juvenile complaint at Irrigon High School on SE Wyoming Ave, Irrigon.

-MCSO received a report at Irrigon Marina on N First St/NW Washington Ave, Irrigon that there are two bunches of leaves dumped at the location and he is concerned that people are using it as a dump area.
