

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

-MCSO received a report on E Hwy 730, Irrigon that RP is doing a repossession of a 1997 Dodge Caravan maroon and owner is not aware.

-MCSO received a report at MCGG Boardman on Rail Loop Dr, Boardman that along the bank of the river there is a vehicle that has been there since last night. Vehicle is older black Honda, possibly an Accord. Unable to locate.

In the game against the Umatilla Vikings, Tyler Carter led the team in scoring with 14. He also had three rebounds and two steals in the game. Justin McAninch was next with 10 points, four rebounds and a blocked shot. Wyatt Steagall scored seven points, had 12 big rebounds and two blocked shots for the Mustangs. Beau Wolters contributed four points, one rebound and one assist. Logan Burrigh scored three points, had three rebounds and an assist. Alex Lindsay and Hunter Nichols scored two points each in the game. Alex also had three rebounds while Hunter had two rebounds and two assist. Gibson McCurry had one point, three rebounds and an assist. Trent Smith

did not score but he had two rebounds and one assist in the game.

The Mustangs then traveled to Echo to take on the Cougars. Steagall led the team with 14 points and nine rebounds on the night. Nichols followed with 10 points and eight rebounds. McAninch was next with nine points, several rebounds and three blocked shots. McCurry scored eight points, Smith seven and Wolters had five points. Burrigh was next with three while Lindsay and Carter scored two points each in the game.

Up next for the Mustangs is a tournament in Irrigon. The team will take on Liberty Christian High School from the Tri-Cities on Thursday at 4:30 p.m. On Friday they will play another school from Washington when they take on the team from Waitsburg at 1:30.
