

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

January 5: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on SE Utah Ave, Irrigon that female and child need assistance. Deputy provided courtesy ride to females and spoke to mother about situation.
