Box 428), Lexington, Oregon, 97839, until 1:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, March 22, 2018. The bids will be publicly opened and read at the Morrow County Public Works Department, 365 West Highway 74, Lexington, Oregon, at 3:30 p.m. local time on Thursday, March 22, 2018. First Tier Subcontractor Disclosure Forms will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. on date of the bid opening. The County may reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may reject for good cause any or all bids upon a finding of the County that it is in the public interest to do so. The bidder must be registered with the Construction Contractors Board. The work will consist of constructing concrete footings, columns and walls as shown in the Project Plans titled "LEXINGTON YARD BUILDING FOUNDATION". The contractor will construct the form work and provide, haul and place concrete reinforcing steel, building anchoring bolts and structural concrete according to the Project Plans. Morrow County Public Works Department will perform all site preparation, excavations and backfill as required. The work will consist of, but may not be limited to, the following total estimated unit cost quantities: Mobilization, Lump Sum,1; Steel Reinforcing for Concrete, 59,500 Lbs; 1"dia x16" Anchor Bolts, 152 Ea.; Concrete for Footings (4000 psi), 290 Cu. Yds; Concrete for Walls & Columns (4000 psi), 150 Cu. Yds. This is a MORROW COUNTY Project by and through THE MORROW COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, fully funded by Morrow
