

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

March 1: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report at SE Thirteenth St/E Hwy 730, Irrigon that someone ran into a fence and looks like they are trying to get out quickly.
