gon county facilities. The commission just completed holding public meetings on the new facilities at most communities in the county.

The commission heard a sheriff's report which said for the month of August there were a total of 46 arrests in the county, 17 motor vehicle accidents, nine concealed handgun licenses issued and 189 traffic stops.

An anonymous letter was read regarding a mem-

ber of the public "dumpster diving" or removing items from the dumpsters at the transfer station. Sandi Pointer of public works said dumpster diving is not permitted at county transfer stations and the rule is posted. Commissioner Jim Doherty said if the letter writer was not willing to sign their name, he did not want to discuss the matter further.
