

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

July 11: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on SE Utah Ave, Irrigon that a lowered black Chevy drove by five times with yard debris, driving fast and dumping it on Tenth.
