Boardman project nearly complete

The city of Boardman's water and sewer upgrade project that began in March is nearing completion. The city appreciates the patience shown by the residents as many roadways were impacted during the improvements.

Roadways in the Faller Road, Mt. Hood and Mt. Adams area have been closed over the last couple weeks, making it difficult for traffic to get around. The

paving is almost complete in those areas.

These water and sewer upgrades have been in the planning stages since 2014. The upgrades will ensure reliability and flexibility in the city's water system, improving fire flow. The sewer project corrected several problem areas. City contractors plan to have the project completed in December.
