MORROW COUNTY LAND USE HEARING

THE MORROW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS will hold the following hearing of public interest on Wednesday, March 27, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. at the Bartholomew Building, Heppner, Oregon. Comprehensive Plan Amendment AC-129-19: Corey Miller, applicant. Mark and Shannon Miller, and Keven Haguewood, owners. The property is described as tax lots 300 and 500 of Assessor's Map 1S 26. The property is zoned EFU and located along Cutsforth Road northeast of Lexington. Request is to add a locally significant aggregate site to the Morrow County Comprehensive Plan (MCCP) Inventory of Natural Resources - Aggregate and Mineral Resources. Criteria for approval is found in the MCCP Natural Resources Element and Review and Revision Process which incorporates the criteria found in the MCZO Article 8 Amendments. This is the second of at least two public hearings with the final hearing before the Board of Commissioners. Opportunity to voice support or opposition to the above proposal or to ask questions will be provided.
