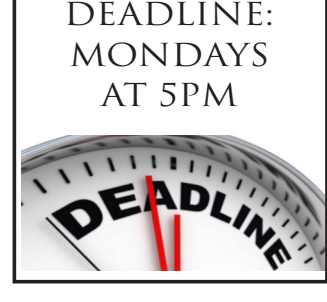
-MCSO received a report on SE Utah Ave, Irrigon that twice a blue Honda Accord ran the stop
