p.m. and high school boys' team from 5-7:30 p.m.

On Wednesday, June 19, 8-10 a.m. is for third to eighth grade; 11 a.m. - 1 p.m. the high school girls' team; 2-4 p.m. will be seventh to 12th grade and 5-7:30 p.m. is the high school boys' team.
