The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

June 12 (cont.): Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on S Front St, Lexington that RP would like a deputy to stop and listen to a message he received regarding his social security. Deputy responded and advised subject it was a scam.
