neighboring waste collectors that the fee schedule for Morrow County residents utilizing the Morrow County Public Works Transfer Stations will be restructured to a per cubic yard charge. Effective January 2020, we feel this is the best feasible way to charge utilizing basic hauler terms and will add some consistency between the stations since all loads include multiple products with various weights and densities. Currently with the two transfer stations, it costs the County an average of \$8.85 per cubic yard to dispose of waste. There will be a minimum fee of \$8.85 (or one cubic yard) and then charged per cubic yard for anything greater than one. The fee is restructured as the follow-

ing:
Length x Width x Height/ depth = ___ divide by 27 x minimum charge \$8.85
Examples:
•4'x4'x1' (LWH): 0.59 cubic yards \$8.85
•6'x6'x1' (LWH): 1.33 cubic yards \$11.50
•8'x16'x4' (LWH): 18.96 cubic yards \$167.50
Morrow County has two transfer stations:

•NORTH-END STATION, 69900 FRONTAGE LANE, BOARDMAN, OR
