CAPECO is still working to help those in our community with their energy bills. We are working from our home offices to assist you. We can still process your energy application through the mail, email, fax and phone.

CAPECO strives to deflect some of your energy costs for income eligible residents of Umatilla, Morrow, Gilliam, and Wheeler counties by delivering the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LI-HEAP) and the Oregon Energy Assistance Program (OEAP). Income eligible households may receive a one-time payment, which is paid to the utility vendor. Eligibility is based on the household total gross income for the last 30 days. For example, a household of four with income at or below \$4,163.92 will qualify for assistance.

The stimulus payments from the CARES Act, which can be up to \$1,200 per person or \$500 per child, are not counted as income.
