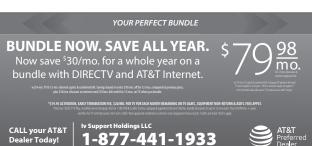


#### **TOWN COUNCIL PO-SITIONS AVAILABLE**
