Summary:
 This measure would authorize up to \$8,475,000 million in principal amount of general obligation bonds. If approved, this measure would finance capital costs, including:
 • a new fire station;
 • land for the fire station;
 • a new structural fire engine; and
 • emergency vehicles to replace older vehicles.
 The District's current fire station was built as an all-volunteer facility 50 years ago. The new station would accommodate the District's 24 hour a day response model, improving response times and allowing the District to meet national standards for emergency medical care and fire service.
 The estimated annual tax rate would be \$0.24 per \$1,000 of assessed value. A property with an assessed value of \$100,000 would pay approximately \$24. Actual levy rate may differ due to actual interest rates and/or changes in assessed value. Bonds may be issued in separate series; each series would mature within 21 years or less.

they are functioning properly. They are important because if a valve is not working properly on a sprinkler system hooked to the town water system, ground water could seep back into the pipes and contaminate the town's drinking water.
 The council also heard a report from Reid Miller of the fire department. Miller reported that the fire department has three new members which is good news for the small

department as they have had difficulty recruiting members in the past. Miller also said he was looking at a truck in Echo for possible purchase as the town needs another one to replace aging equipment. The department is also looking at one from Ione to buy. The council also voted in favor of purchasing a new tool box for the department from Harbor Freight in Hermiston for \$500.
 The council also heard a report from Councilmem-

ber Gordon that the 10-ft utility trailer the town was waiting for would not be available until October. She said, however, there was a 12-ft trailer available now for \$250 more. She recommended moving forward with the longer trailer and the council agreed. The council also voted to sell an older used city pickup truck to a council member who offered to buy it. The pickup had been advertised to the public for sale but no one had bid on it.
