

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

July 30 (cont.): Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report of a disabled vehicle on I 84 E, Boardman, Vehicle parked off the roadway.

-MCSO received a report at SE Utah Ave/SE Seventh St, Irrigon that a green Toyota Echo ran the stop sign at Eighth. Unable to locate.

-MCSO received a report at SE Utah Ave/SE Seventh St, Irrigon that a short be red Chevy pickup sounded like it punched the gas near his residence and ran the stop sign at Seventh at 30 mph. Unable to locate.
