

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

August 20: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on Linden Way, Heppner of a confrontation with her kids. Advised a man in a van pulled up and threatened them with a gun downtown.

-MCSO received a report at Pleasant View Rd, Irrigon of three dogs loose. Kari Goodhardt was given verbal warning for dog as a public nuisance, dog at large.

-MCSO received a report at Hwy 207 Echo, Echo of a deer in the roadway.

-MCSO received a report on Doolittle Canyon Ln, Heppner of barking dogs from his neighbors since 0600. Deputy responded, nothing of note was located. Unfounded.
