Wolf advisory committee seeks applicants

Morrow County is seeking applications from individuals interested in serving on the Morrow County Wolf Depredation Advisory Committee, an advisory committee to the Board of Commissioners. The committee consists of seven members: two wolf conservation representatives, two livestock producer representatives, two local business representatives, and one county commissioner. The current vacancies are for a wolf conservation representa-

tive, a livestock producer representative and a local business representative.
The purpose of the Wolf Depredation Advisory Committee is the administration of the Oregon Department of Agriculture's Wolf Compensation and Financial Assistance Grant Program. The committee meets to discuss ways to assist livestock producers with non-lethal deterrent methods and, when appropriate, the dollar amount to be distributed in the event of a proven wolf depreda-

tion. Term lengths are four years. The committee meets every other month in Heppner, except May-August, or on an as-needed basis.

Suzanne Lieuallen Jepsen

Suzanne Lieuallen Jepsen, 92, peacefully entered the Lord's presence on November 28, 2020. She was born October 26, 1928, the second of two children to Cecil "Buck" and Violet (Hynd) Lieuallen. For over 65 years she was the loving and supportive wife of Bob Jepsen, who preceded her in death on July 19, 2016.

Suzanne grew up in Pendleton, but spent many summers visiting cousin Doris at the Hynd Brothers' Ranch at Cecil and summer pastures near Heppner and Ukiah. As a teen, she had a dramatic role in the annual Happy Canyon Pageant. She played the part of a pioneer woman captured by the natives, who escaped by jumping off a cliff and racing away on horseback.
After graduating from Pendleton High School in 1946, she put her riding skills to further use as a Pendleton Round-up Princess. She then attended

what is now known as Oregon State University for a year before taking a job in a local doctor's office. During this time, she met her husband-to-be, Bob Jepsen of Ione, while skiing at Spout Springs. Suzanne fell and broke her arm, and Bob, who was on ski patrol that day, came to her rescue.
The relationship took off from there and led to their wedding on June 25, 1951.

The young couple moved to the wheat ranch near Rhea Creek where Bob had been farming. While there, they were blessed with two children, Susan and Bill. In addition to helping on the farm, as the children grew older, Suzanne started working in Heppner for Dr. Wolff, and later supervised senior meal sites for a multi-county area. When Bob retired from farming in 1991, they moved into Heppner. She devoted much of her time to church and community activities and was instrumental in building the Willow Creek Terrace Assisted Living Facility.

Suzanne loved her Savior, Jesus Christ. She and Bob were long-time faithful members of All Saints Episcopal Church and later, Hopeful Saints. They were founding members of the Cursillo ministry at All Saints, along with Ned and Kathy Clark, Bob and Marion Abrams and Pauline Winter, after it was gifted to the Episcopal Diocese of Eastern Oregon in 1975. She was active in the ministry until recent health issues prevented her from participating. "The Cursillo Community of Eastern Oregon is an ecumenical community of faith, love and hope, that supports and energizes individuals in their search for discover of and renewal in Christ."
Suzanne delighted in her grandchildren and

the great grandchildren who called her "Grandma GG." She and Bob especially enjoyed attending the grandkids' music and sports events. Up until the age of 89, when she entered assisted living, Suzanne was involved in a wide variety of activities: golfing, Bookworms Club, helping seniors at Willow Creek Terrace and kids at AWA-NA Bible Club, women's Bible studies, bridge club, birthday club and exercise classes. "She leaves a heritage of Christian faith for her family and was an inspirational example of prayer, grace, class, and hospitality," her family reported.

Those left to cherish her memories are her daughter, Susan Bullington of Umatilla; son, Bill (Nancy) of Enterprise and six grandchildren: Brad (Tracy) Bullington, Matthew (Erin) Jepsen, Daniel (Bethany) Jepsen, Eric (Caitlin) Jepsen, Amy (Tyler) Schaffeld, and Rebecca (Richard) Matthews. Also 11 great grandchildren: Blake and Brody Bullington, Natalie, Seth, Cody, Abi, Laurelee, Anna, Cecily and Adelaide Jepsen, and Whitney, Jacey and Tessa Schaffeld. She was preceded in death by her parents, brother, Frank and husband, Bob.

A Celebration of Life was held on Sunday, December 13, at Willow Creek Baptist Church in Heppner, followed by a graveside service at the Heppner Masonic Cemetery.
