

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

September 20 (cont.): Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on Washington Ln, Irrigon that RP had an altercation with a tenant that lived on their property. RP advised that she has a broken leg/foot. RP was transported to GSH advising of foot pain. No visible injury to foot.

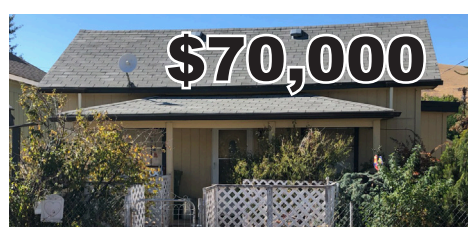

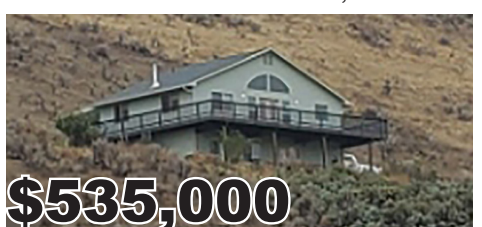
