

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

October 20: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on SE Utah Ave, Irrigon that a black Ford F250 swerved towards him when he was out walking.

-MCSO received a report on C Street, Ione that subject has been harassing her daughter. Under investigation.

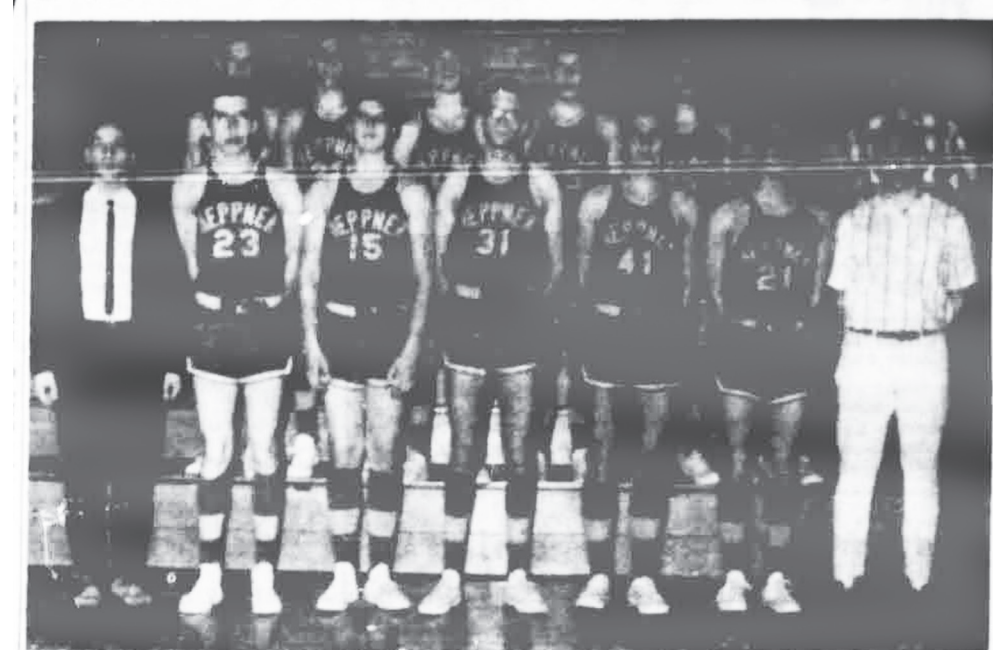
-MCSO received a report on NW Jones ST, Heppner that there is a kid chasing him around town and harassing him. MCSO made contact with the male.

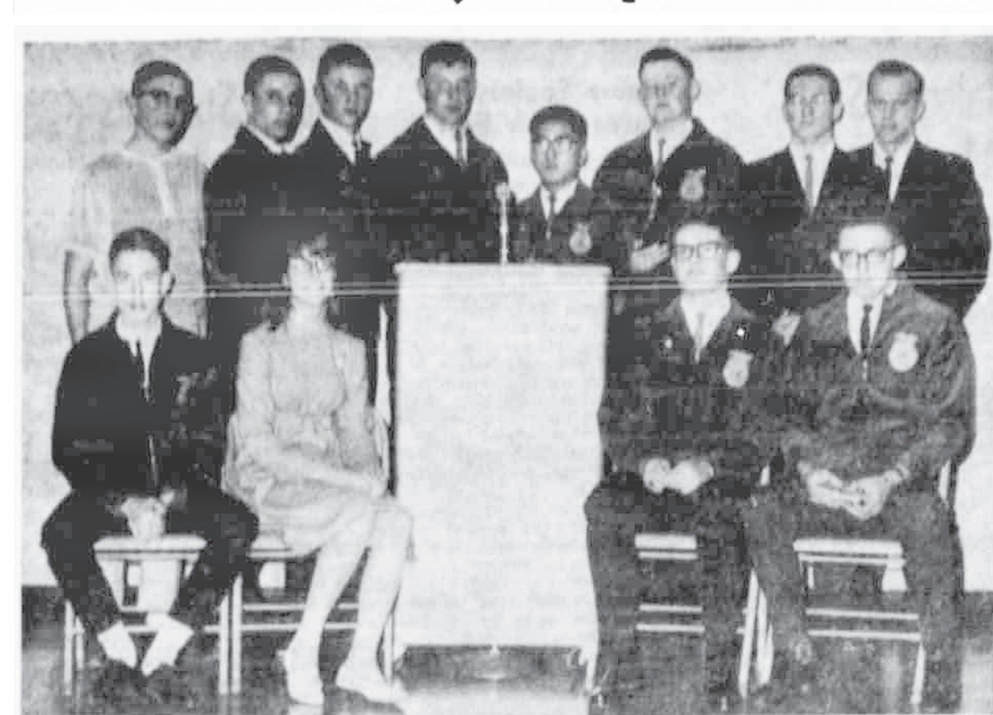
