Morrow County District Attorney Justin Nelson has released the following report:

-Casey Anthony Scott was convicted of contempt of court - violation of a restraining order and sentenced to 24 months bench probation, 90 days in jail,

90 days suspended upon successful completion of probation, 20 hours of community service work imposed, \$550 fine/assessment, no contact with victim, and must continue to comply with restraining order and any other court orders.

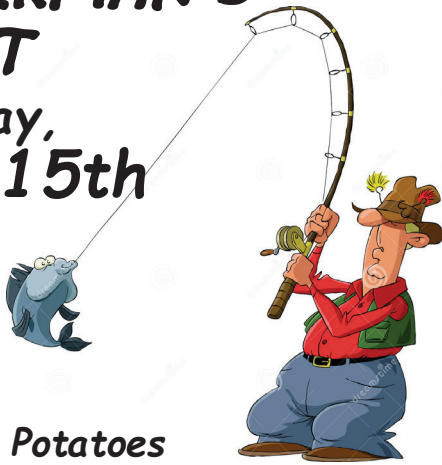

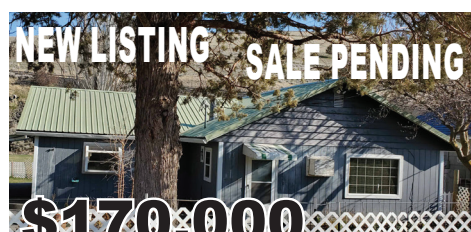
