

# Highview cemetery to expand



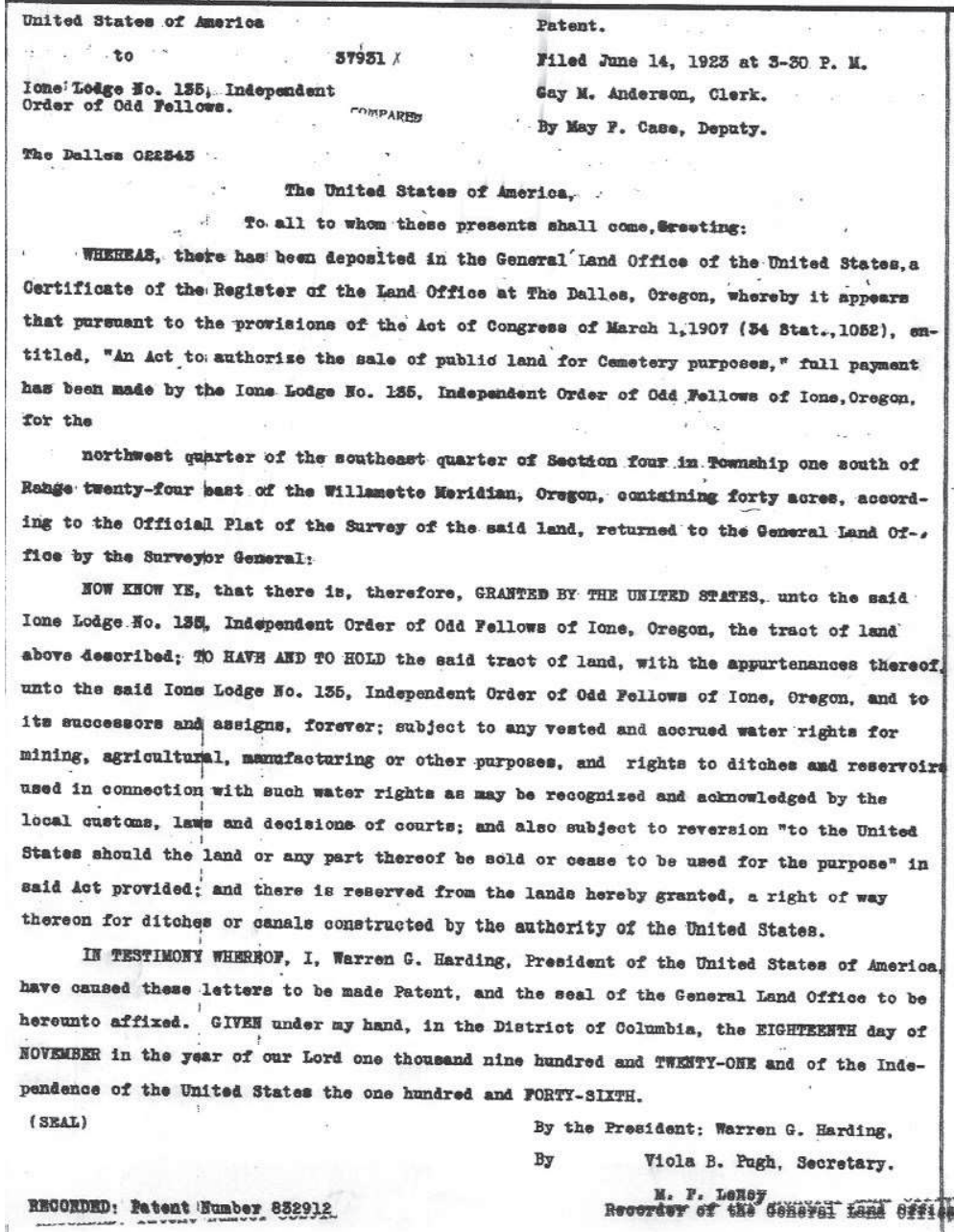

purchase. The land was deeded to the Ione Lodge No. 135, Independent Order of Odd Fellows as "An act to authorize the sale of public land for cemetery purposes" by President Warren G. Harding on the "Eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine

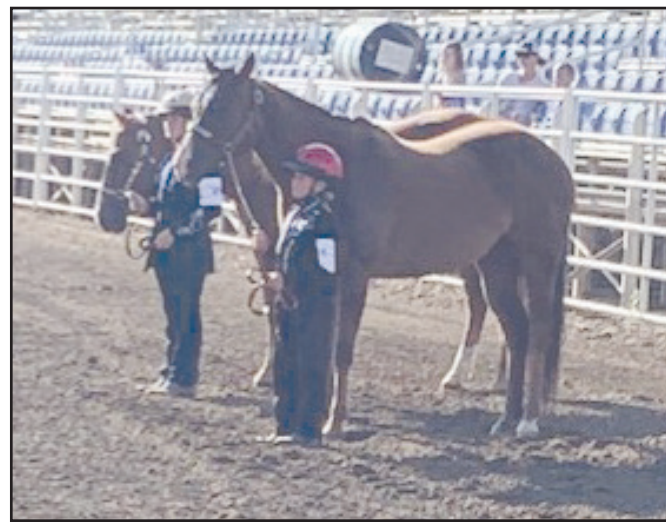
hundred and twenty-one" stated the document from nearly 100 years ago. (See below)
