

Sheriff's Report

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-MCSO received a report on Se Utah Ave, in Irrigon. Caller advised that the road between Utah and California is currently blocked off and the city doesn't want people driving on it. Caller stated that the road is open right now for the trucks to go through, but people are still driving on it. He said there was just a black ford with a car on the back that went through. MCSO checked the area, no signs posted that the road is closed
