

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

**May 2:** Morrow County Sheriff's Office received a report on W Oregon Ln, Irrigon that caller heard shots in the area. Unknown where they came from, 7-10 shots. Caller believes it was a handgun. Unable to locate.

-MCSO received a report at S First St/SE California Ave, Irrigon that units are out with an individual and vehicle involved with UPD shooting.

-MCSO received a report on I 84 W, Boardman that a Honda Accord is swerving all over the road. Referred to other agency.

-MCSO received a report on I 84 W, Boardman that there is a large piece of wood in the middle of the left lane of travel. Caller nearly hit it. Referred to other agency.

-MCSO received a report at E Hwy 730/SE Seventh St., Irrigon of a disabled motorcycle. MCSO checked, they have help coming.

-MCSO received a report on SE Utah Ave, Irrigon that a gray Honda Passport is moving at a high rate of speed toward Tenth.

-MCSO received a report on SE Utah Ave, Irrigon that a gray Dodge Caravan is moving at a high rate of speed toward Tenth.
