

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

July 15: Morrow County Sheriff's Office received report of a parking complaint at Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Heppner. The original incident was re-opened, and the report was canceled.

-MCSO received report from an Irrigon resident that her neighbor on the corner has two pit bulls that were attacking her horses. MCSO responded and spoke to the owners of the dogs and the horses.
