The Morrow County Sheriff's Office has released the following information:

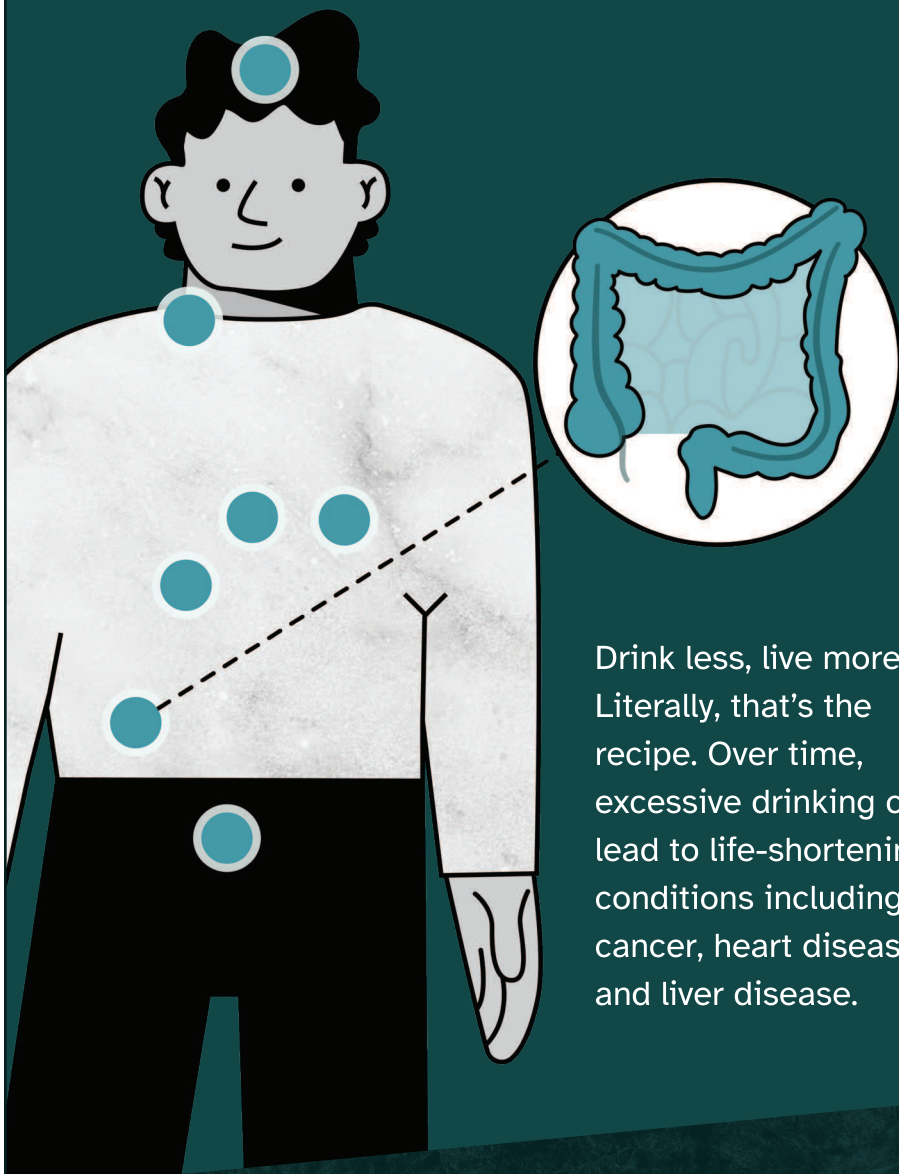

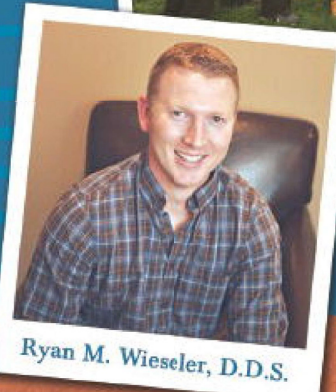
