Related Businesses Within The Town of Lexington QUESTION Shall The Town of Lexington Prohibit Psilocybin-Related Businesses and Manufacturing within The Town of Lexington? SUMMARY State law allows operation manufacturing, distributing, and possession of psilocybin and psilocin. State law provides that a city council may adopt an ordinance to prohibit the establishment of any of those registered or licensed activities. Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers and/or psilocybin service center operators within the jurisdiction of the Town of Lexington. EXPLANATION Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment and operation of psilocybin-related businesses within Town of Lexington.
