Boardman man killed in I-84 crash

Boardman man Ricardo Mejia Avila, 27, was killed in a single vehicle crash on I-84 on Christmas Day. A passenger in the vehicle remains in critical condition.

Oregon State Police (OSP) reports that it responded to the call around 6:54 a.m. on Sunday, Dec. 25. The accident occurred on Interstate 84 in Morrow County, near milepost 174.

The preliminary investigation indicated that Avila was driving a silver Mercedes E320 and was traveling westbound when it left the roadway and went into the median. The vehicle then rolled several times,

we headed?" Imes added. "So I'm very excited and hope we can continue to do great work with the Morrow County Planning Department. They're really key in helping these small cities to move forward."

Morrow County Commission Chair Jim Doherty pointed out that the list of available grant funding included grants to help with water emergencies, which would also help the water issues in the North End.

"If we can find funding for the Port of Morrow to complete the CLOMR (Conditional Letter of Map Revision) work at the mill site, that 80 acres of industrial ground could come into use in the Willow Creek Valley," Morrow County Commissioner Vice Chair Melissa Lindsay added, referring to the site of the old Kinzua mill outside Heppner. "I believe fully that if we win that battle, the next one's going to be easier, and that could impact all three cities in potential to use the Lidar (light detection and ranging) to get to a CLOMR. That could impact greatly all three of those cities."

Lidar is a technology used to create high-resolution models of ground
