The Lady Mustangs made their mark at the Buck Track Classic last week when they tied with Baker for third place out of a field of 20. The Heppner women scored 61 points as a team at the track and field meet Friday, April 7, at Pendleton High School.

The women's team also made its mark on an individual basis, with several athletes finding places on the podium and nearly every team member setting personal or season records.

The women's 4x400 relay team of Arianna Worden, Irelynn Kollman, Lily Nichols and Hallee Hisler placed first with 4:34.46.

Lily Nichols placed first in the 800-meter with a personal record (PR) of 2:36.72 and third in the 1500-meter with a PR of 5:14.46. Hallee Hisler placed third in the 200-meter with a season record (SR) of 28.13.

The Heppner men placed seventh as a team with 42 points, and also saw several individuals either place or set personal records. Trevor Nichols placed first in the 1500-meter race with an SR of 4:17.50, and second in the 800-meter with an SR of 2:02.24.
