

# Lady Mustangs hoof to first in Grant Union meet

Heppner women again topped the field as a team at the Grant Union Invitational last Friday, placing first out of the eight teams that participated at Three Flags Field in John Day. Heppner men placed third as a team, while several individuals also had strong performances in the Heppner team's last meet before the district championships this Saturday.

Hallee Hisler proved herself a triple threat, taking first in the 100-meter, 200-meter and 400-meter. Lily Nichols placed first in the 800- and 1500-meter races, while Riley Archer took the top spot in the 3000-meter.

Trevor Nichols placed first in the men's 1500-meter, and Gage Hart took first in the 3000-meter.

The 2A Special District 4 Championships are this Saturday, May 20, at Hermiston. Field events begin at 11 a.m. with track events beginning at 2 p.m.
