Inland Northwest Choral to perform in Heppner

Celebrating its 25th Anniversary Season, Inland Northwest Musicians is thrilled to be presenting a concert by the Inland Northwest Chorale under the direction of R. Lee Friese in Heppner, Oregon at the Gilliam & Bisbee Event Center (106 E. Main Street, Heppner, Oregon) on Sunday, March 10th at 4pm. Featured at the concert will be "Gloria" composed by Antonio Lucio Vivaldi (March 4, 1678-July 28, 1741), an Italian composer and violinist. This piece will be sung in its original Latin language. The soloists to be performing will be Arlene Thompson, Becky Henshaw, and Mary Finney from Pendleton, OR, and Mandy Stewart, Marie Rose and Paul Kelly from Hermiston, OR.

The balance of the concert will consist of a variety of songs with different flavor: A sacred piece combining John Newton's Amazing Grace and Johann Pachelbel's Canon in D arranged by Jean Anne Shaffer; *Go Where I Send Thee*, a Spiritual arranged by Andre Thomas; *No Time*, a Traditional Camp Meeting Song arranged by Susan Brumfield; and *Simple Thanks*, incorporating the Shaker Tune "Simple Gifts" written by Don Besig and Nancy Price (music by Don Besig). is comprised of volunteer musicians from throughout Northeastern Oregon and Southeastern Washington.
