

## Sheriff's Report

### MCSO Dec 28

**-Driving:Complaint**  
Another driving complaint was filed, this time on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon. The caller observed a gold Chevy Yukon or Envoy traveling at high speed towards Tenth Street. The caller speculated that the driver resides on Eleventh Street.

**-Juvenile Complaint:**  
A complaint was received on E Arcade St in Lexington regarding juveniles skateboarding in the area and causing disturbance by making the neighbors' dogs bark. The caller asked the juveniles to relocate, resulting in their parents issuing threats against the caller.

**-Warrant Arrest:**  
During an officer-initiated activity at Short Rd/ Columbia Ln in Irrigon, a white Dodge pickup truck with no license plate was stopped. One of the occupants received a warning for various traffic violations, while another individual, subject H, was arrested by the MCSO on an Umatilla County warrant and MCSO Probable Cause for charges of burglary and theft. Subject H was subsequently lodged at the UCJ without bail.

### MCSO Dec 29

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A silver Dodge Caravan, driven by a female, was reported for running a stop sign on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon. The vehicle was observed speeding towards Division at a high rate of speed. This is an ongoing issue that occurs around the same time of day.

**- Dog Complaint:**  
A large grey Pitbull allegedly attacked another dog while the owner was walking their dog on Se Eleventh St in Irrigon. The Pitbull, belonging to the residents of the above address, approached and jumped on the other dog. When the owner tried to speak with the Pitbull's owners, they shut the door.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A grey Ford Focus was reported for almost hitting a person who was crossing Division St in Irrigon. The vehicle was seen heading towards the high school.

**- Disturbance:**  
A man driving a blue Mazda pulled over on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon and urinated in a field. The individual then drove away in a blue hardtop two-door car, heading down Tenth St.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A blue two-door Fiat was witnessed running a stop sign on Seventh St in Irrigon and then speeding towards Tenth St. The license plate details could not be obtained.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A dark blue Chevy Envo was reported for speeding on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A gold Ford Ranger, late '90s model with a toolbox and Washington license plate, was observed speeding down Tenth St in Irrigon.

### MCSO Dec 30

**-Runaway:**  
An eight-year-old child was reported missing from their residence on Se Cowins St in Heppner. The child was last seen in their pajamas, and all their belongings, including their jacket, were found at home.\*The child was located.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
A yellow van with Washington plates was reported for speeding on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon, heading towards Division.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
A grey f150 extended cab was reported for speeding on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon,

heading towards eighth and Knapp St. The caller also mentioned their intention to locate the vehicle and run the license plate. However, the caller was advised not to interact with the driver, but has since disconnected.

**-Unauthorized Use of Motor Vehicle:**  
A vehicle theft was reported at Baltimore Apartments on Nw Baltimore St in Heppner. The theft occurred between now and last night, involving a 2010 two-door Kia.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
A dark blue Chevy Cobalt was reported for speeding on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon, heading towards first and then turning left.

**-Theft Complaint:**  
A cold theft was reported on Highway 74 in Lexington. The reporting party believes that their shop was broken into on the 26th, as per their trail cam footage. The only items missing were a Dewalt drill and a couple of gas cans, which the reporting party finds suspicious.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
A black Dodge short bed 4d was reported for speeding at a high rate on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon, heading towards tenth.

**- MVA-Fire:**  
A single motor vehicle accident without injuries and not blocking the road occurred at the intersection of Columbia Ln and Paterson Ferry Rd in Irrigon. - The responsible party was issued citation #46498 for failing to drive within the lane (811.370).

**- Disturbance:**  
A disturbance was reported at an address on Columbia Ln in Irrigon. The reporting party stated that their son has been making threats towards them and requested that he be asked to leave.

**- Shots Fired:**  
Gunshots were reported at the area near W Highway 730 and W Eighth Rd in Irrigon. Witnesses reported hearing 3 or 4 shots fired in the direction of the Gravel Pit.

### MCSO Jan 1, 2024

**-Warrant Arrest:**  
A subject was arrested at the Morrow County Sheriff's Office on W Willow View Dr. in Heppner. The individual was arrested by the Pendleton PD on an MCPP Detainer #20CR46700/01 and was subsequently lodged at UCJ with NO Bail.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
A driving complaint was reported on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon. According to the report, a silver Ford F150 extended cab short bed was observed speeding from Tenth Street towards Division. The reporting party heard the vehicle rapidly accelerate and witnessed it running a stop sign at Seventh Street and Utah Ave.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
Another driving complaint was reported on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon. In this instance, a white old Ford flatbed truck was seen speeding towards Se 10th Street, while a two-door Honda Civic was observed driving at high speed towards the same location.

### MCSO Jan 2

**- Noise Complaint:**  
A noise complaint was reported on Canal Ln, in Boardman. The caller stated that their wife heard someone outside the residence. The caller is in route to the location but requested a unit to respond as well.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A driving complaint was filed regarding a silver Toyota SUV on Se Utah Ave, in Irrigon. The caller informed that the vehicle was speed-

ing and did not stop at the stop sign. It was further mentioned that the driver, who is a student, has been seen in different vehicles multiple times.

**- Citizen Assist:**  
A citizen assist was reported on Nw Riverside Ave, in Heppner. Multiple calls were received from OHS and APS regarding a male who allegedly made threats to kill someone.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A driving complaint was registered regarding a gray Dodge pickup truck with a white cargo trailer on Se Utah Ave, in Irrigon. The caller reported that the vehicle had its strobe light on and was speeding towards tenth. This seems to be an ongoing issue involving a construction worker.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
Another driving complaint was received about a truck with a caution light on top, towing a box trailer. The vehicle was observed flying down Utah Ave towards Division and intentionally circling the block to harass the caller. The vehicle is believed to be from the site at Division/Hwy 730.

**- Parking Complaint:**  
A parking complaint was made on Se Utah Ave, in Irrigon. A grey Chevy Equinox was parked in the wrong direction, causing a blind spot.

**- Parking Complaint:**  
Another parking complaint was reported on Se Utah Ave, in Irrigon. A vehicle with license plate 203PHL was parked on the corner, obstructing the view of oncoming traffic. The vehicle is silver in color and has been reported to have a loud noise due to the lack of a muffler. The caller requested contact via phone or in person.

**- EMS:**  
On Se Utah Ave, in Irrigon, a male was bitten by a dog, leading to the need for emergency medical services.

**- Disturbance:**  
A disturbance was reported at Green Acres on Paterson Ferry Rd, in Irrigon. The caller stated that their son, was threatening to destroy their property and causing disturbances in the area.

Subject brought in on transport to Umatilla County Jail for a parole board warrant for PV, lodged at UCJ.

**-Driving Complaint:**  
A white Dodge Journey was observed speeding towards the school from Se Utah Ave.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A red Dodge pickup, short bed, four-door, was reported to be speeding towards Tenth on Se Utah Ave.

**- Vandalism:**  
A report was received from Love's Travel Stop and Country Store on Tower Rd. regarding a vehicle that was vandalized while the owner was at work during the previous night.

A car crash was reported on Main St N in Boardman, with the individuals involved claiming that they had taken someone's wife who speaks

Spanish.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A silver Equinox was reported to be speeding excessively and making excessive noise due to a missing muffler on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A red Dodge pickup belonging to a male driver with multiple vehicles, including a gold Tahoe, was reported to be speeding through the area towards Tenth on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A silver Volkswagen Passat was observed speeding towards tenth on SE Utah Ave in Irrigon.

**- Driving Complaint:**  
A deputy vehicle was seen going through towards division on SE Utah Ave in Irrigon, closely followed by a dump truck. The reporting party noted that the dump truck was driving at an excessive speed, ignoring the stop sign on Seventh, and producing a loud noise as it hit the pavement.

through it and removing his firearms. The daughter and son-in-law were described as squatters.\*Subject DOB: 11/03/1993 was arrested by MCSO for I 66.270 Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and 164.354 Criminal Mischief II, to be lodged at UCJ for no bail\*

### MCSO Jan 6

**- Trespass:**  
A report was received regarding trespassing on E Highway 730 in Irrigon. The reporting party (RP) noted that two individuals were seen smoking a cigarette on the property of a burned house. The RP has requested contact from a deputy regarding this incident.

**- Abandoned Vehicle:**  
A request for assistance was made regarding an abandoned vehicle on Hilltop Rd in Boardman. The RP has asked for a deputy to visit the location and issue a 272 notice to remove the abandoned vehicle. Case number: 2401060103.

**- Suspicious Activity:**  
A report was filed regarding suspicious activity on Se Gilmore St in Heppner.

The RP explained that there is a shed on her mother's property with a padlock on it, which no family member has placed there. The RP expressed discomfort in opening the shed without a deputy present, as there may be concerns of tampering or hidden items on the property.

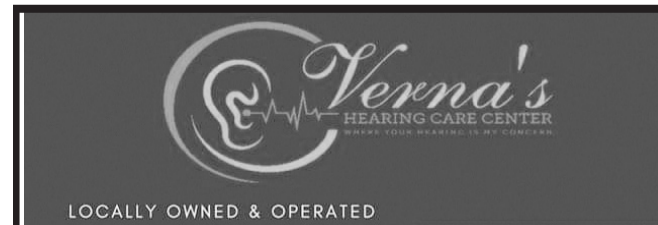

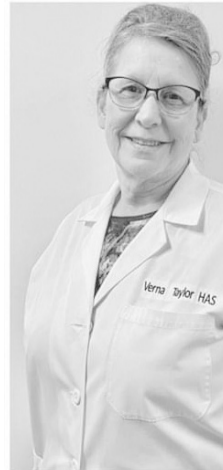
