plan going forward for the citizens and residents of Morrow County and Heppner, thank you." This concluded the communication from the public. (The Gazette reached out to the City and they confirmed they are working on an MOU to address these issues.)

During the meeting, the Heppner Fire Department reported on their recent activities, including smoke detector installations, lift assists, a structure fire, a non-injury vehicle accident, and the installation and testing of a new generator for the firehouse. They also mentioned joint training with HRFPD and a grant request for Wildland Staffing with the Oregon State Fire Marshal. The Morrow County Sheriff's Office reported their deputy hours, which totaled 450 hours in Heppner for March. They reported 49 traffic stops, 48 warnings, 1 citation, and 13 dog calls. Council member Adam Doherty expressed concerns about a crosswalk near Dollar General, stating that he had almost been hit several times. Deputy Larson assured him that he would address the issue with the other deputy. The Heppner Public Works Director reported on various projects, including water leaks, septic dumps, install-

ing a new handicap parking sign, and attending training conferences.

City manager John Doherty provided updates on the OTL network cameras at the City Park saying he is working on getting them online and discussed options for chip sealing and seal coating the streets of Heppner. He mentioned a pre-application for transportation and growth management funding and addressed property owners refusing to pay Transient Room Tax. Doherty also had a meeting regarding an affordable housing program in Boardman and the potential for expansion to other Morrow County cities. He discussed mutual aid between Heppner Fire and Morrow County contracted ambulance services and requested approval for an intergovernmental agreement with the Willow Creek Park District.

During the new business portion of the meeting, the council discussed an intergovernmental agreement with the Willow Creek Park District for groundskeeping and pool maintenance. They also discussed South-end Transfer station vouchers, surplus property, possible grants for city park improvements, updates on the Economic Development Committee, and the Heppner daycare's search for a building. They decided to discuss Ms. Johnson's suggestions in the next month and planned a work session for May to follow up on St. Patrick's event.

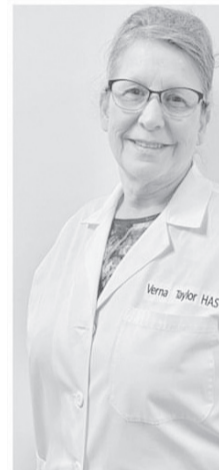
