

## Sheriff's Report

### MCSO Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

#### Driving Complaint

A black Chevy Equinox was reported speeding on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon, heading towards tenth. The Sheriff's Office was advised but out of position to respond.

#### Fireworks Complaint

Two shots fired or fireworks were reported in the area of Se Gilmore St in Heppner. The Sheriff's Office checked the area but was unable to locate the source.

#### Driving Complaint

A black Dodge Caravan was reported driving at a high rate of speed towards tenth on Se Utah Ave in Irrigon. The vehicle was also observed without any lights on. The Sheriff's Office was advised of the complaint.

Cold temperatures and a steady drizzle greeted participants at the Mustang Invitational in Heppner last Thursday. Nine teams attended the middle school track and field event, with more than 50 participants in some events.

While the weather may have dampened moods and slowed times, it didn't prevent several South Morrow athletes from taking top spots and setting personal records in their events.

Several local athletes placed in the top five of their events against stiff competition. Aidden Ramos of Ione placed second in the 400 Meters, while Mustang Ketch Fennern placed first in the 300m Hurdles. The Heppner men's relay team placed second in the 4x200 Relay.

Mustang Catherine Lindsay placed first in the 400 Meters and second in the 200 Meters. Mikalie Duncan of Heppner placed second in the 1500 Meters and fourth in both the 800 and 3000 Meters. Andee

Lathrop placed second in the 300m Hurdles and fifth in the Long Jump, and the Heppner women's relay team placed second in the 4x200 Relay. Mustang Abby Sumner placed third in Shot Put.

Personal records were also in abundance. Charlie Mullins of Heppner set a PR in the 400 Meters. Mustang Luke Imes set a PR in the 800 Meters. Axton Hendricks of Heppner set a personal record in the 1500 Meters.

Mustangs Samantha Lamb and Lakelie Thompson each set a PR in the 100 Meters. Mikalie Duncan of Heppner set a PR in the 1500 Meters. Andee Lathrop of Heppner set a PR in the 300m Hurdles. Lizzie Ginn of Heppner set a personal record in the Shot Put and the Long Jump.

Aidden Ramos of Ione set personal records in the 100 Meters, 400 Meters. Cardinals Bryson Bailey and William License each set a PR in the 100m Hurdles - 30".
