

Sheriff's Report

MCSO April 1st

Animal Complaint

Occurred at W Fourth Rd/Idaho Ln, in Irrigon, OR. RP advised that there were 3 black cows and 4 calves with red ear tags in the road. He was able to get them into the pasture right there since it had an open gate but he is not sure if that is where they belong. MCSO checked the area. Disposition: UNABLE TO LOCATE.
