

Sheriff's Report

MCSO April 5th (cont)

Dog Complaint

Occurred at E May St/ SE Chase St, in Heppner, OR. A black lab that almost attacked a kid's dog while he was walking it, last seen headed towards Despain Pizza, unknown owner, unknown if it had a collar on RP does not need contact, but is available at Bucknums if needed.
