EXPLANATION

Restricted revenue from the opioid class action settlements was in recorded incorrectly in a prior fiscal year. The error was discovered in the current fiscal year. This adjustment will increase budgeted transfers out of the General Fund and into the Opioid Abatement Fund which was a new fund created in FY2025 for the purpose of accounting for this restricted revenue.

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
