The American Cowboy Team Roping Association National Finals was held October 19th through the 26th, 2024, in Reno, Nevada. Our area was represented by Cecil's Tate Turner, who brought home

the Reserve Champion #4 title, roping with Jeff Every of Redmond. The competition featured teams from all over North America, with 920 teams vying in the #4 roping. The duo brought home \$5325 each and tro-

phy saddles. This is the second team roping saddle Tate won this year. In July, the 12-year-old captured the Silver State Invitational Rodeo Junior High Team Roping title, roping against kids from 7 western states.
