COUNTY UNIT BILL

Full Text of Senate Bill No. 45 Providing for Consolidation of School Districts, Election of a County Board, Etc.

A BILL For an Act establishing a county school district in all counties of the State having twenty-five thousand or more children of school age...

Section 1. In all counties of this State having now, or hereafter, a population of twenty-five thousand or more children of school age...

Section 2. The term of office of each member of the county board of education elected at such first election shall be for the term of one year...

Section 3. Each member of the county board of education shall, within ten days after receiving notice of election...

Section 4. All the property, real and personal, belonging to the second and third class districts...

Section 5. The duties of the county board of education in county school districts shall be:

(1) To establish and maintain elementary schools, high schools and vocational schools...

(2) To employ teachers, janitors, carpenters, etc. and to fix their compensation...

(3) To lease and build school houses, and to buy and lease land for school purposes...

(4) To make an annual report to the taxpayers of said district...

(5) To fix a tax to be levied for the support of the district...
